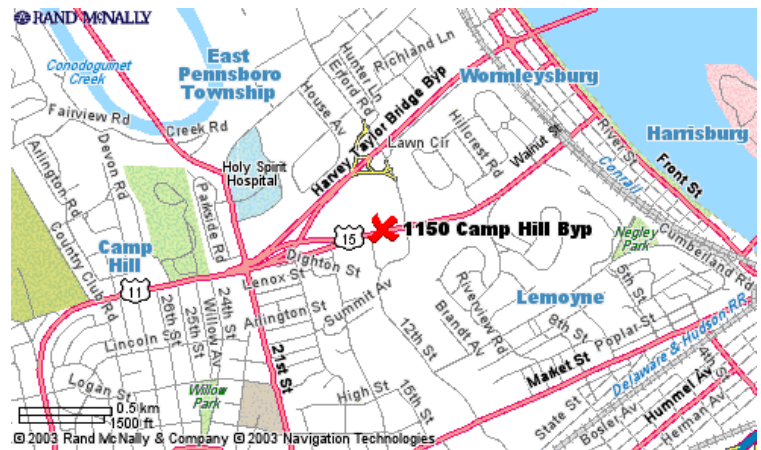

Hotel Directions

Philadelphia Area

Travel I-76 West (PA Turnpike) to Exit 236 (Gettysburg). Go North on Route 15 for about 6 miles. Radisson is on the left.

Pittsburgh and Points West

Travel I-76 East (PA Turnpike) to Exit 236 (Gettysburg). Go North on Route 15 for about 6 miles. Radisson is on the left.

Allentown and Bethlehem

Travel I-78 West to I-81 South and take Exit 65 (Enola/Marysville). Travel Routes 11/15 South for about 5 miles. At the 5th traffic light, turn right onto Walnut Street. Go straight for two more lights, and the Radisson is on the right.

York, Baltimore and Washington D.C.

From the PA Border travel I-83 North to Exit 41A (Camp Hill-Route 581 West). Then take Exit 5A (Camp Hill-Route 15 North). Follow Route 15 North for about 2 miles and the Radisson will be on the left.
