Travel 1-79S to I-579 (Veteran's Bridge). Take the Seventh Avenue exit, and then continue onto Seventh Avenue. Turn left onto William Penn Place, and Kimpton Hotel Monaco Pittsburgh is on the left.

Travel I-79N follow signs to I-376 East to Pittsburgh. Follow I-376E to Pittsburgh. Take exit 71A on the left to merge onto Grant Street. Turn left onto Seventh Avenue, then again onto William Penn Place. Kimpton Hotel Monaco Pittsburgh is on the left.
